

League Bylaws 2014 – 2015

- Farmington Youth Bowling Board of Directors will take care of all business and handle all grievances during the bowling season. All rules will be reviewed and adopted yearly prior to the start of each bowling season. The Board of Directors shall consist of the following:
 - President Youth will elect
 - Vice President Youth will elect
 - Secretary / Treasurer Farmington Lanes
- All junior league members must be sanctioned. Membership is open to both boys and girls who have not
 yet reached their 20th birthday as of August 1st of the current bowling season. There is a \$25 program fee
 per bowler and is broken down as follows:
 - Youth Sanction \$10, Youth t-shirt \$10 & Expense \$5
- Each league member will be required to pay a weekly fee of \$10. All league members must pay their bowling fees weekly and on time in order to remain in the league. Fees breakdown is as follows:
 - \$9 will cover the cost of the bowling (3 games and shoe rental)
 - o \$1 will cover prizes for end of season
- League will determine wins and losses on a handicap basis and using the individual handicapping method. Handicap will be factored as follows: 90% or 210 with no limit.
- We will use a seven point system. Each Youth league will bowl a split season of 9 weeks each third. At the conclusion of each league there will be a roll off to determine league champions. Teams that win each third will earn a spot in the roll offs at the end of the season. If there is a tie at the end of each third, there will be a 1 game roll off to determine a winner. The seven point system is broken down as follows:
 - 2 points for each team game
 - 1 point for team total pins
- There will be a minimum number of players that is needed to make a legal line up. The players will need to be present by the completion of the third frame of each game. Minimum players needed is as follows:
 - Saturday Youth Early 2 players
 - o Saturday Youth Late 1 player
- Each league has a maximum number of players allowed to participate on each team at any given time. For those teams that do not meet the maximum number of players allowed will have a vacant player added to its roaster. The vacant will have a score total of 120. If a bowler is absent, their absentee score shall be the bowler's average less 10 pins. Team sizes are as follows:
 - Saturday Youth Early 4 players
 - Saturday Youth Late 2 Players

- Bowlers will establish their league average in the first three game league session.
- Electronic devices are not allowed during league competition. Bowlers caught using any such devices will be warned once. Upon second warning the device will be confiscated for the remainder of league and the bowler will receive a zero for that frame in which the infraction occurred.
- All bowlers are to maintain good sportsmanship, use proper language, and respect all league coaches, bowling center employees, bowling center equipment and all other bowlers. Proper attire must be worn for each scheduled league day.
