



Parent/Guardian | Participant Code of Conduct 2014 – 2015

All parents/guardians and players are expected to conduct themselves appropriately at all team functions and abide by the following rules and guidelines.

Parents/Guardians:

I/We will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support in both verbal comments and actions for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other related youth sports event.

I/We will treat and ask my child to treat all players, coaches, and officials with dignity, honesty and respect in language, attitude, behavior, and mannerisms regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.

I/We will remember that the game is for youth - not adults.

I/We will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child and other team members.

I/We will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win through my words and actions.

I/We will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I/We will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth bowling events.

I/We will require that my child's coach uphold the Coach Code of Conduct.

I/We will respect the property and equipment used at any bowling center.

I/We will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my athlete or the safety of others.

I/We will provide necessary documents and registration information.

Participant:

I will treat all players, coaches, and officials with dignity, honesty and respect in language, attitude, behavior, and mannerisms regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.

I will put forth my best effort at all youth bowling events.

I will not use drugs, tobacco and alcohol products.

I will accept the responsibility for player/team related communication with my coach and organization.
